Golden Rules for the Site

1. If you don't feel comfortable with a job, don't do it. We can always find you another job with which you are comfortable.
2. Be aware of your surroundings.
3. Safety glasses **MUST** be worn at **ALL** times. Earplugs **MUST** be worn any time you use power tool. Hard hats **MUST** be worn any time work is going on overhead. **NO EXCEPTIONS!!**
4. No one is allowed on the roof without special instruction and safety equipment. No one!
5. Keep an open mind! Try everything, and remember there is always another way to do it!
6. Every tool has a home – put it back where it belongs.
7. You will be assigned to a work crew. Stay with this crew. Do not wander off or disappear. If you wish to be reassigned to a different crew, speak to a Construction Supervisor.
8. Your work team supervisor's word is what goes! Listen to him or her.
9. Don't be bossy. Your work team supervisor is in charge, not you.
10. Personal conflicts (no matter how small) should be referred to a Construction Supervisor.
11. Treat your coworkers with respect. They are as eager as you to learn and to work. Respect them. If they are less skilled than you, take on the role of teacher.
12. When in doubt, **ASK!** There is no such thing as a stupid question!
13. Quality of work is what matters, not quantity!
14. **ABSOLUTELY NO SMOKING ON OR AROUND THE WORKSITE!** You will be asked to leave.
